Where's the Outcry?

...we promised we'd never forget...

When the horror of the Holocaust was exposed at the end of World War II, we promised we would never forget, and we would never let it happen again. When we studied the atrocity in school our jaws dropped in shock and asked how the world could have let this happen on its watch, but it did.

It still boggles our consciences today when we think back to what those horrible realities must have been. The scars from that horrific reality in history have marked the Jewish community today. Most of them have a family story they can tell us about or that of close friends, their remnants, the survivors of those train cars to death, gas chambers, and concentration camps. Hidden tattooed numbers speak of an unimaginable past.

That generation is now moving into their final years. History is already trying to erase the reality of what happened so that brutality will become folklore and its heroes are forgotten. But we do know today. We are the possessors of this truth. Eleven million men, women, and children were murdered and approximately six to seven million of these were Jews. It is reported that one-third of all Jewish people alive at that time were murdered in the Holocaust. Unbelievable! Unimaginable!

But wait.

We are just as guilty today of not paying attention to what's really happening like they didn't seventy years ago. In the 1940's, eleven million people were being taken captive and being systematically killed. It's heartbreaking to report that today's numbers dwarf yesterday's horrifying count.

There are over 215,000,000 Christians in captivity today who are tortured, raped, beaten, enslaved, crucified, and killed in the most terrible ways. That is more than twenty times the number of people of the Holocaust. This is today's Holocaust. Another 85 million are facing some type of persecution for their Christian faith.

North Korea is crushing Christians. Somewhere between 80,000 to 120,000 are political prisoners where they sustain unbelievable torture for their faith.

Iraq is expelling Christians; for the first time in history, Mosul is now empty of Christians. I've reported on the story of Zaid Subhi who fled for his life from there. He and his family escaped. They are Christian Chaldeans.

In Syria, sex slavery is driven by Sharia law. Christians are forced to convert to Islam or endure humiliation, taxation, and potential execution at any time. Trafficking of Christian women and girls is commonplace.

Iran has criminalized Christianity. A typical charge could be "acting against national security." Christian prisoners endure severe mistreatment, including beatings and solitary confinement.

Saudi Arabia prohibits Christians from living in its borders. They have cleansed their country of all churches, crosses or Bibles. You cannot work in Saudi Arabia unless you are Muslim.

Yemen will not tolerate Christians. Christians there live in fear of being murdered and tortured.

Libya beheads Christians. The world viewed the assassination of the Coptic Christians on the beach a few years ago. Libya is steeped in human trafficking, slavery, and Christian torture.

Mexico. Who would have dreamed that this country would now be the most dangerous place on earth for clergy? Save The Persecuted Christians recently reported our southern border neighbor "...with the second largest Catholic population in the world, is more dangerous for a priest than in Syria or Iraq."

Egypt is experiencing massacres. Coptic Christians are being forced underground as they watch their churches destroyed, Christians kidnapped, no employment for Christians, forced marriages, and other abuses.

East Africa is imposing Sharia in the most vicious way. Pastors crucified while watching their wives being raped in the view of their children. The terrorized kids are then forced into sex slavery or other types of human trafficking.

I could go on: Sudan (State-sanctioned terror), Nigeria (genocide), Rwanda (disappearing Christians), Indonesia (inciting violence), Mali (abusing children), China (tracking Christians), etc.

Where is the outcry?

The common factor in *most* of these countries, most of them located in the cradle of civilization and Christianity, is Islam. Islam is not the religion of peace the mouthpieces declare it to be, unless you understand in Islamic terms what that word means. Peace to a Muslim means that all Christians, Jews, and Zoroastrians are gone, and everyone has submitted to Islam. So, when we're agreeing that we want peace, too, they're laughing as they nod their heads at our words, as we agree to our own demise.

When will we stop accommodating Islam?

When will we stop playing into their hands thinking being "peaceful" will change things?

When will the Pope realize he is leading his followers into the very hands of Satan himself?
