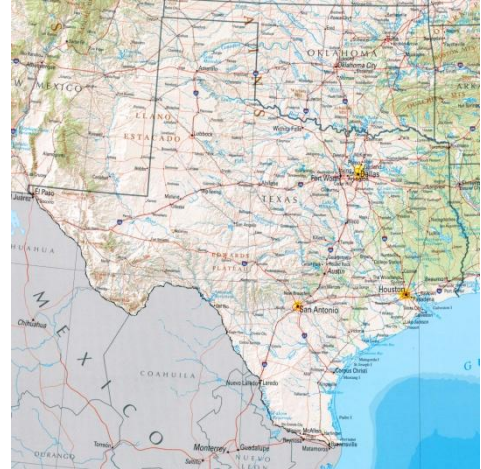


Bastardized...
